GRANTS

The Downtown Exchange Club of Billings will consider the following statements in awarding grants.

1. Normal grants will be in the \$100 - \$500 range.
2. Grants usually will only be given to recognized non-profit organizations deemed to be in need of our help.
3. Priority will be given to those most in need and/or youth oriented.
4. Grants usually will be awarded only for one time projects that do not require continual funding by the Exchange Club.
5. Other factors influencing our decision will be:
 - a. Purpose and need.
 - b. Number and age group of people to be helped.
 - c. Procedure and accountability to be followed.
 - d. Has the grantee received grant funds previously, within the last 3 years, from the Downtown Exchange Club of Billings.
 - e. Is the Downtown Exchange Club of Billings the only contributor to this project? If not, how is the balance being raised?
 - f. How will the organization report back to the Downtown Exchange Club of Billings on the project?
